Study New York EducationUSA Outreach

China Outreach: Jody Lehr, Associate Director, International Outreach, Enrollment Management, Rochester Institute of Technology (RIT), organized a presentation and mini fair for Study New York for more than 150 students and parents at the EducationUSA office in Beijing on March 19, 2015. This is the third year Ms. Lehr has worked with EducationUSA in China to raise the visibility of New York higher education. Parents and students were enthusiastic. The audience was surprised to learn that more than one-third of international students studying in New York State attend only five NYS-based universities, leaving two thirds to study at the other 265 colleges and universities in the state.

India Outreach: Lokesh Shivakumarajah, Assistant Director of International Recruitment and Admissions, Metropolitan College of New York organized a series of Study New York sessions in Mumbai, Chennai and New Delhi to promote educational opportunities in the state of New York. Study New York also participated in Pre-Arrival Orientation in New-Delhi.

Over 200 students and their parents participated these sessions. Sessions covered topics such as:

- Studying in New York
- International Student Life in the U.S.
- Secrets to excelling in U.S. Higher Education
- College Search, Admissions Requirements and Scholarships

Study New York at Istanbul, Turkey Recruitment Fair

Study New York participated in the 2014 International Education Fairs of Turkey (IEFT), a recruitment fair, in Istanbul, Turkey from November 15 to 17. There were 185 exhibitors, 125 representing higher education. Visitor attendance totaled 8,100 for the Istanbul European side and 1,550 for the Asian side. Study New York's booth attracted many interested students over the three-day event. Maria Conzatti of Nassau Community College represented Study New York at the event. Because the organization has a large representative membership, IEFT was generous to provide a free booth for Study New York.


Study New York Annual Meeting


